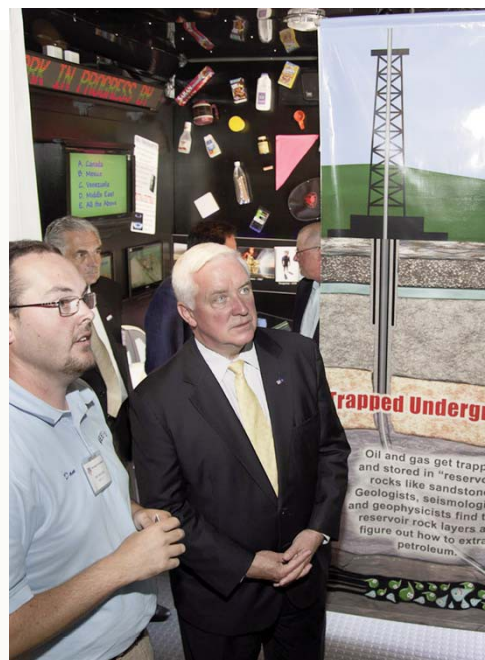

## MEET-U'S 3000 VISITOR DAY



MEET-U was invited to participate in the 2010 Boy Scouts of America Campanza at Moraine State Park, September 25. With over 9,000 scouts registered for the three-day event the MEET-U team knew that they had the potential to visit with a lot of people. We moved the trailer into position on Friday morning and picked up our passes for the next day. Due to the amount of scouts, all exhibitors and participants were shuttled into the park from the Butler County Fair Grounds. After exiting the bus at the display area, the team quickly realized that they were going to be in for a busy day. The trailer officially opened its doors at 9 am and from 9:15 to 11:30 the exhibit had a line that stretched out the door down the ramp across and down the road for 10 to 15 yards (see pictures below). Wait time to enter the exhibit ranged from 20 to 30 minutes. The day slowed down around lunch time with only a five-minute wait to enter the trailer. By 4:30 the MEET-U team had talked to over 3,000 scouts, leaders, and parents.
